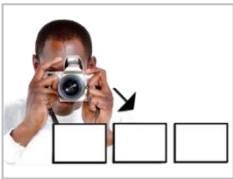

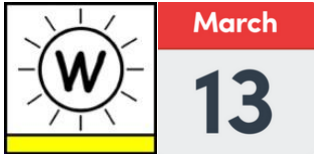

Nhs England Job application EasyRead+ session



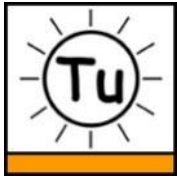
It was great to have Ravi from NHS England joining our EasyRead+ session

- **Get out** of the building and get to a safe place



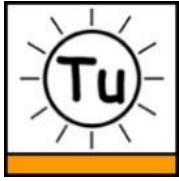
- **Do Not** try and put the fire out yourself

It was interesting and good to do because we got to learn about young offenders and how they are treated by the law

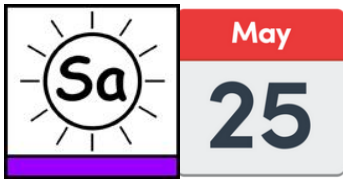
