



Last October we went to the SOUP event to give a presentation on our **Disability Hate and Mate Crime (DHMC)** project,


Out of the four charities we won!








Our **Disability Hate and Mate Crime** Project is about bringing awareness to the abuse that people with learning disabilities go through daily



Emma Anderson is a 33 year old woman with down syndrome, who discovered a love for art. Her work was entered in a competition and won, now her work is on display at the Tate in London






