

We feel that everyone has a right to be able to get information in a way that they are able to understand



On our monthly visit to New Shoots we took our **Disability hate and** mate crime project




We showed pictures of **Disability hate and mate crime** and asked them to tell us which was a hate crime and which was a mate crime

This **text number 61016** is a way for you to let the police know something is wrong or worrying you


If you do not want to call them always text this number **from a safe place**



We will be joining in to support Anti-bullying Week on Monday for **Odd Socks Day** in support and hope that you will too



Hate Crime Drop in Surgery




This **Hate Crime Drop In surgery** has been set up to help people who have been the victim of a Hate Crime to support them to report it or to get help

There will be lots of information on Hate Crime, it is open to everyone.





We will also be having a presentation from the British Transport Police and Transport for London


