The clocks go forward on Sunday 31st March.

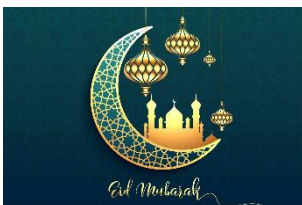
Ramadan

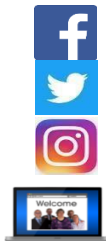
