Grenfell

On 4th September, the Prime Minister, Keir Starmer, apologised to the victims of the Grenfell Tower fire that happened in 2017, killing 72 people.



The government did not see the danger of the building material used and the companies involved will all be held responsible.



Queen Elizabeth II

The anniversary of the death of Queen Elizabeth II was 8th September 2024, making it two years since she sadly passed away.

A ceremony was held in Walsall on September 15th to remember the late Queen Elizabeth II.



At the ceremony, a statue made in her memory was revealed, which can be found outside of Walsh Funerals & Memorials in Bloxwich.



Donald Trump

Donald Trump was nearly killed in a second shooting attempt.

A man was arrested after trying to shoot Trump with an AK-47 gun at the Trump National Golf Club where he was playing.

Gunshots were fired next to Trump, but he was not injured.



Tito Jackson

Tito Jackson, an original member of The Jackson 5 and brother of Michael Jackson, has died aged 70.





On September 10th the government introduced a temporary early release plan to reduce the amount of people in prisons.

This caused the amount of people in prison in England and Wales to drop by over 2,000 in 7 days.



The plan allowed prisoners to be released early if they have served 40% of their sentence, instead of the previous 50%.



Those selected are people in prison for thefts, drug dealing, fraud and violent crimes up to four years.



This does not include people in prison for more serious crimes, such as sex crimes, terrorism, some domestic abuse offences or violence over four years.

The early release plan could free up 5,500 spaces in prison cells.


